

## HARVEST PERMIT APPLICATION TO OPERATE ON OUT-OF-STATE LICENSE PLATES

Purpose: Use this form to apply for a permit to operate a vehicle with out-of-state license plates in Virginia while under contract to harvest and/or haul crops to a storage house, packing plant, market or transportation terminal:

- as an incidental part of harvesting operations

- not to exceed a distance of 20 miles and
- when the use is a seasonal operation

Instructions:

Applicant and Farm owner/lessee complete and sign their respective sections. Applicant submits completed application and presents vehicle registration to any DMV customer service center to receive a Harvest Permit (RDT 387).

Harvest permits are valid for 90 days from the date of issuance.
